A beautiful desert island in the middle of The Great Salt Lake, Antelope Island is home to a free-ranging bison herd, bighorn sheep, pronghorn antelope and thousands of migrating birds, and is a bird watching paradise. Dedicated birders can spend hours at the island's top two birding hotspots, the causeway and Fielding Garr Ranch. Hiking trails take visitors to spectacular views of the Great Salt Lake and the Wasatch Range. Those interested in geological history will enjoy seeing some of the oldest exposed rock formations (1.7 billion years) in the country. Antelope Island is a Utah State Park. The visitor's center offers trail maps, bird checklists, and information about wildlife viewing. This trip is appropriate for any individual as tours of the island can be made by automobile or bus.
